You may qualify for financial assistance!

The City of San Diego and the Metropolitan Area Advisory Committee on Anti-Poverty of San Diego County, Inc. (MAAC) have launched the **Solid Waste Management Fee Financial Assistance Program** to help eligible homeowners reduce out-of-pocket costs for their trash and recycling fee.

Who qualifies?

- You own and live in your home as your primary residence.
- Your home receives City trash and recycling service.
- AND you meet one of these:
 - ▶ Household income is at or below 60% of California's State Median Income
(*Example: One person – \$3,331/month; Four people – \$6,407/month*).
 - ▶ Someone in your household is enrolled in Medi-Cal, CalFresh, CalWORKs, SDG&E CARE or the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

What's available:

- Half fee
- Full fee*

*Must meet criteria above AND be on payment plan for past due County property taxes.
